We take the landowner goals and objectives into account along with the characteristics of the forest to develop silvicultural treatments and cutting cycles that are unique to each property.

Timber Sale Process

- Advisement during bid opening as to acceptable bids and contractors.
- Negotiation and administration of the contract between the landowner and timber buyer.
